**MOTION TO CONFIRM AUTOMATIC DISSOLUTION  
OF INJUNCTION**

In the recent special session, the Legislature passed legislation responding to this Court's judgment, affirmed by the Supreme Court, that the school finance system is a state property tax prohibited by Article VIII, §1-e of the Texas Constitution. The Governor has signed this legislation into law. The State Defendants believe that this legislation rectifies the constitutional deficiencies described in the Supreme Court's opinion and that, as a result, this Court's injunction has automatically dissolved.




