- Historic designation guarantees builders follow the rules. For historic homes, the City permitting process is reviewed by the HAHC.
- Historic designation preserves our neighborhood's character and architectural uniqueness!

In June 2011, City Council approved the Woodland Heights Historic District (WH HD). Since June 2010, every Certificate of Appropriateness requested by WH HD residents has been approved by the Houston Archaeological and Historical Commission (HAHC) without delay!
